

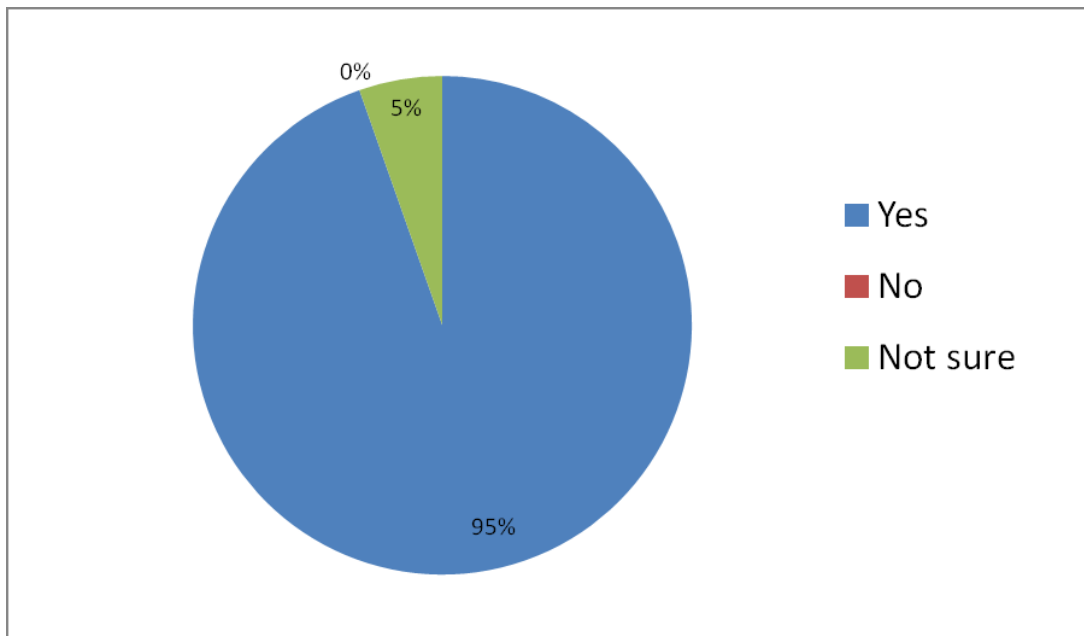
Health Related Behaviour Questionnaire Results 2014.

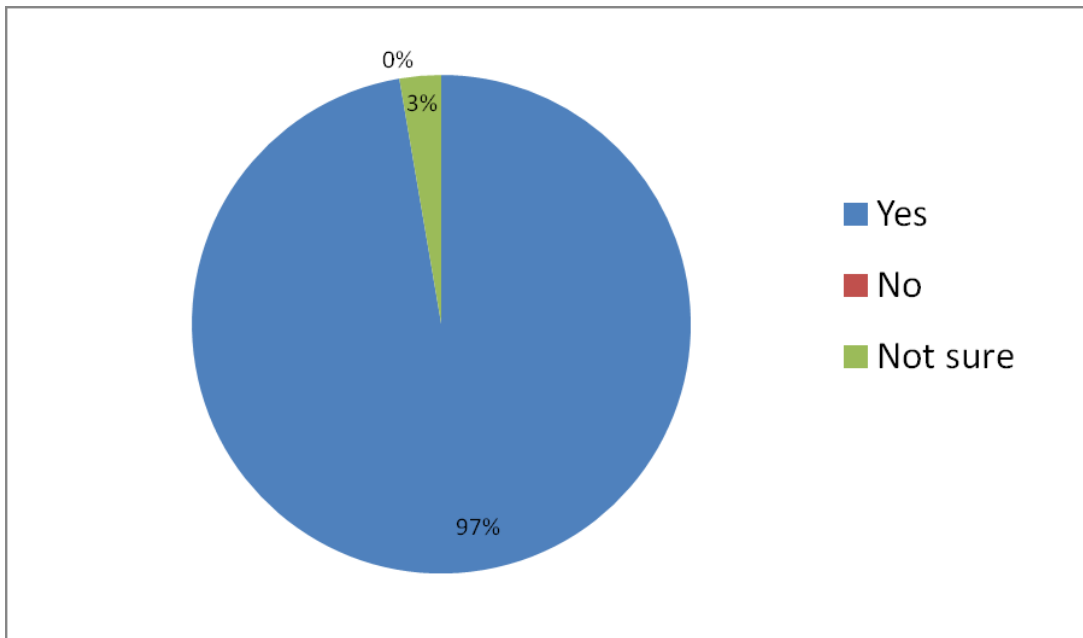
Below you will find some of the key results from the questionnaire.

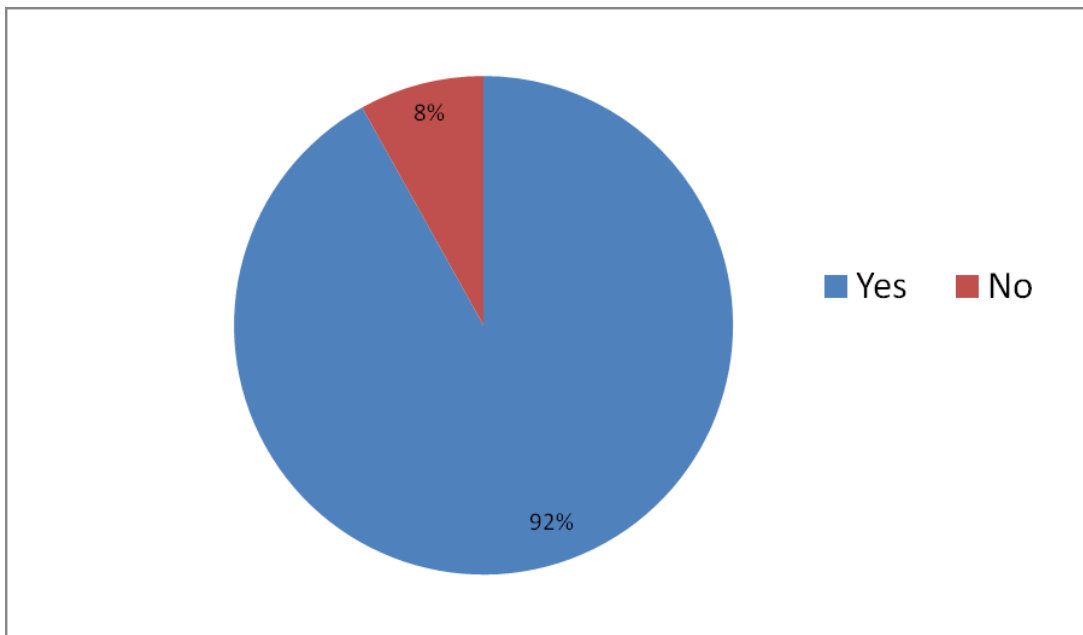
The school cares whether I am happy or not.



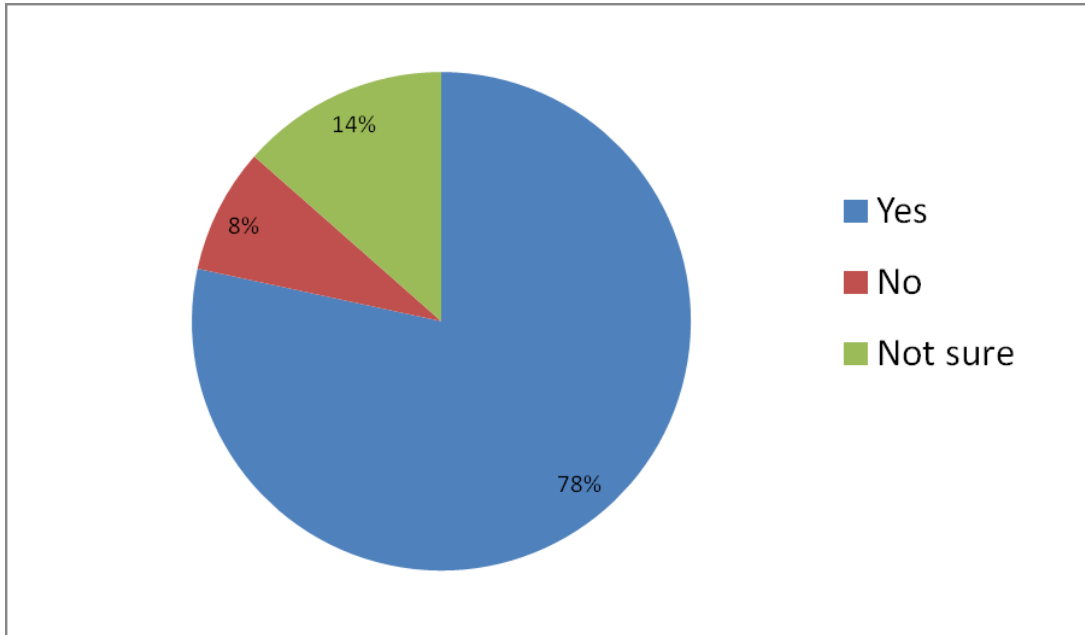
My work is marked so I can see how to improve it.



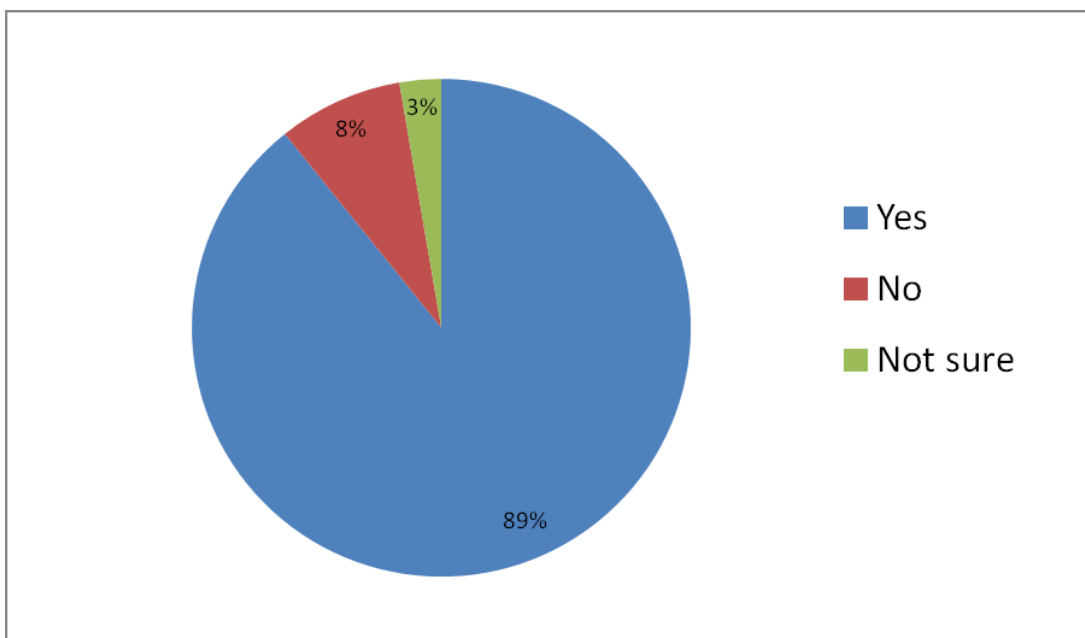
I know my targets and I am helped to meet them.



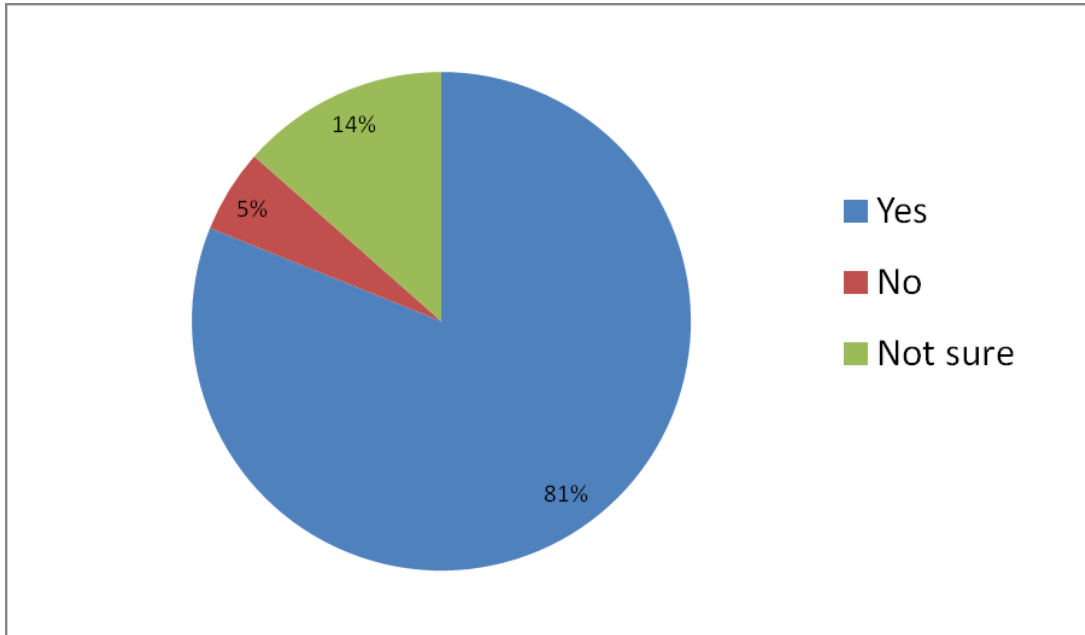
My achievements in and out of school are recognised.



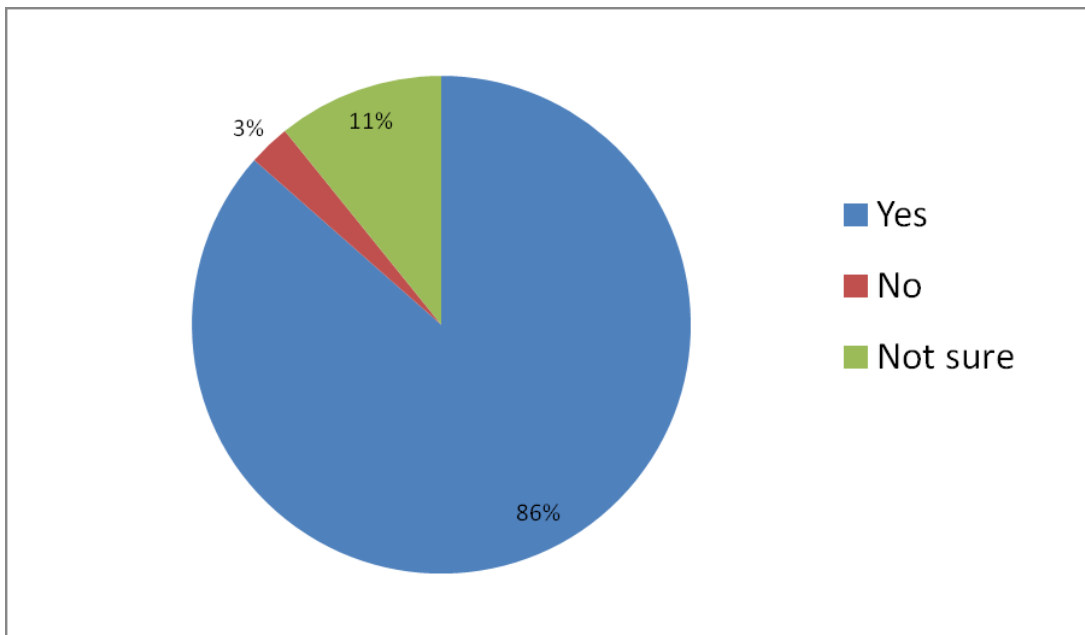
The school teaches me how to deal with my feelings positively.



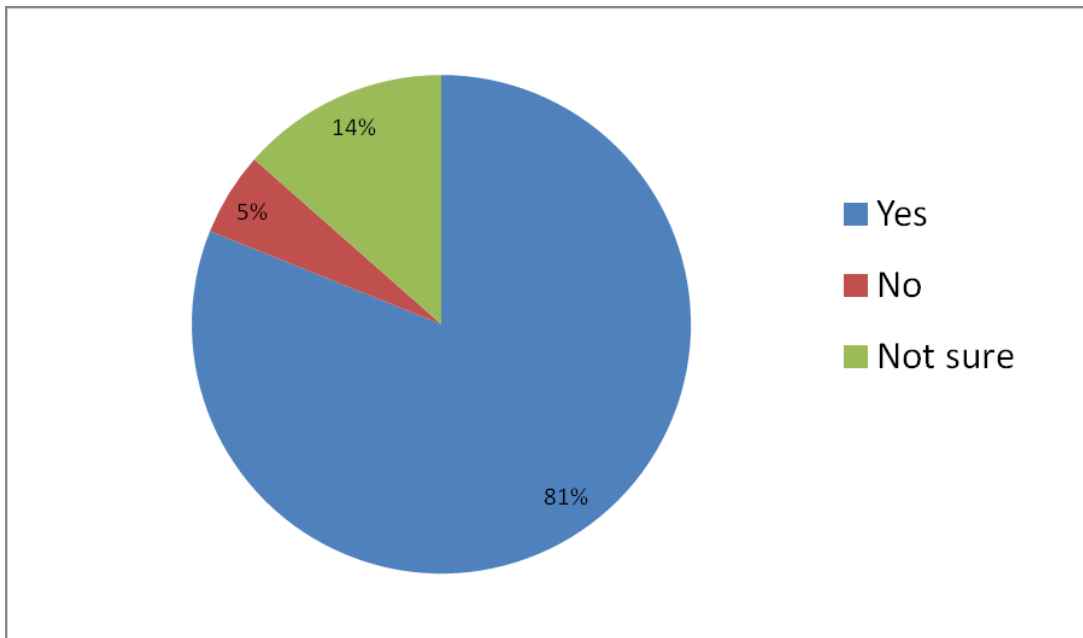
The school helps me work as part of a team.



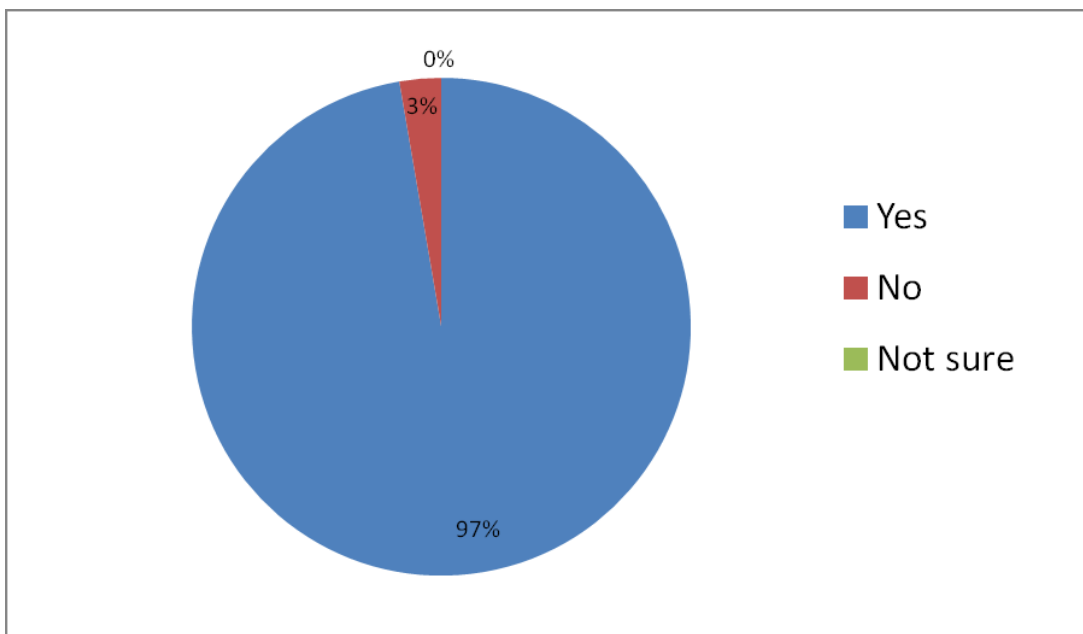
In this school, people with different backgrounds are valued.



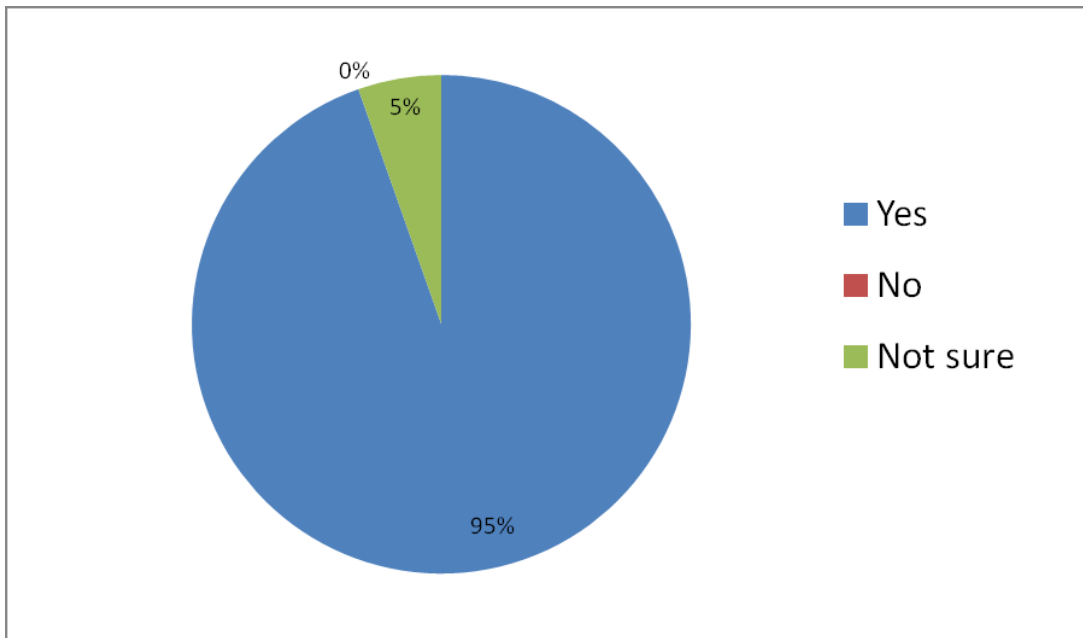
The school encourages me to contribute to community events.



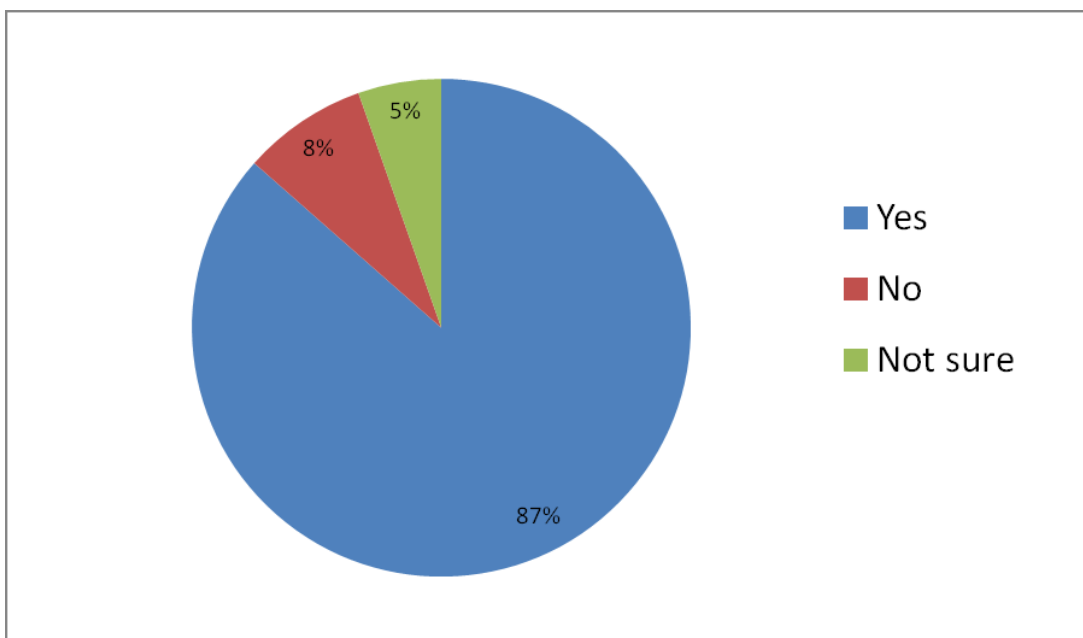
The school prepares me for when I leave this school.



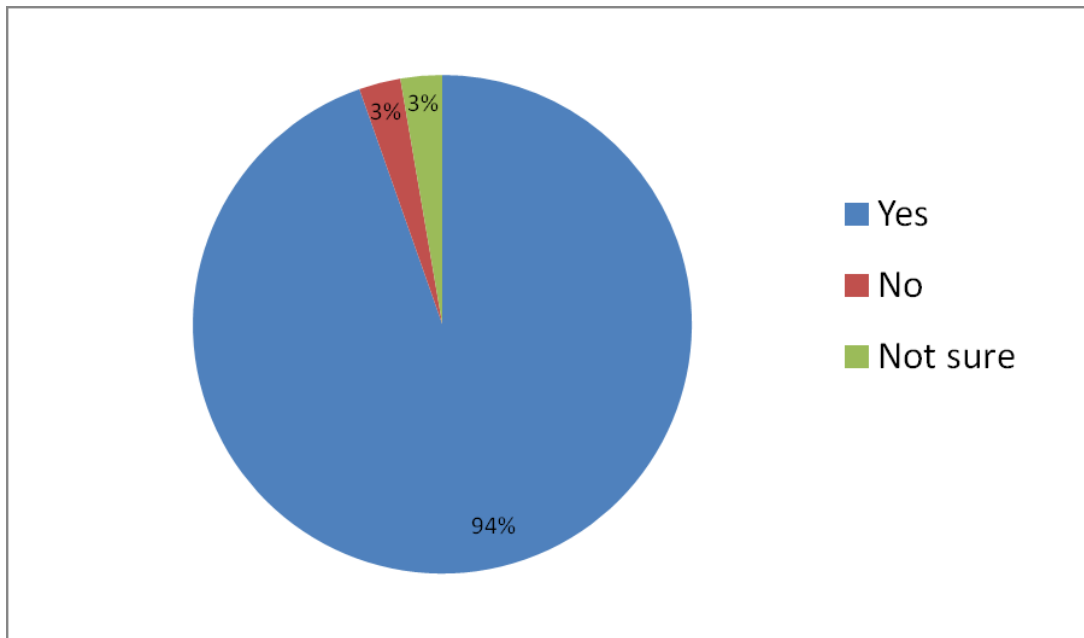
The school encourages everyone to treat each other with respect.



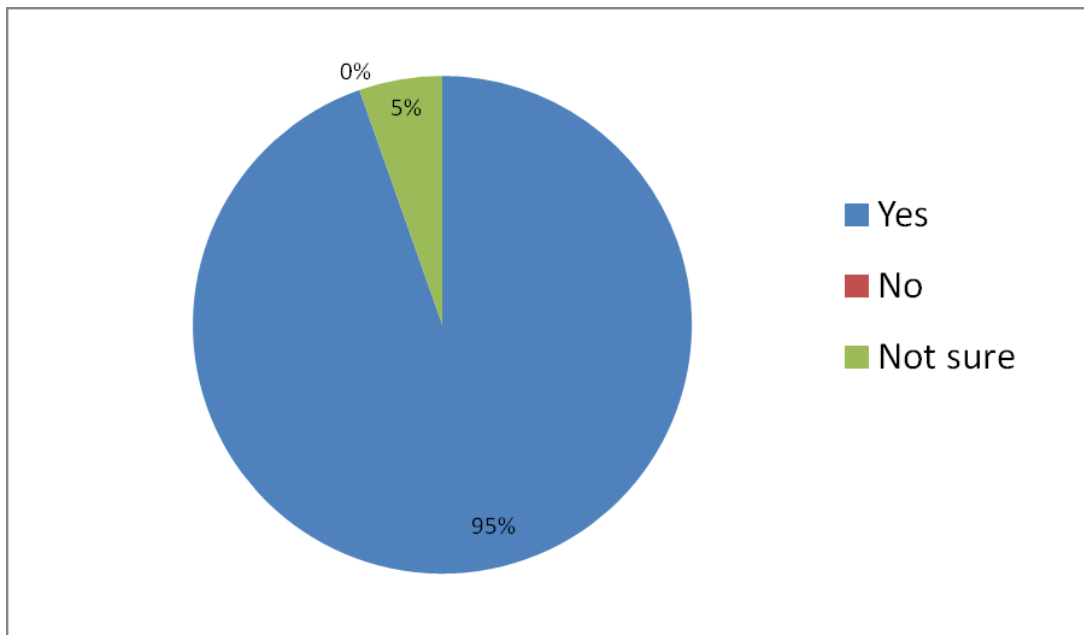
My teacher realises when I don't understand.



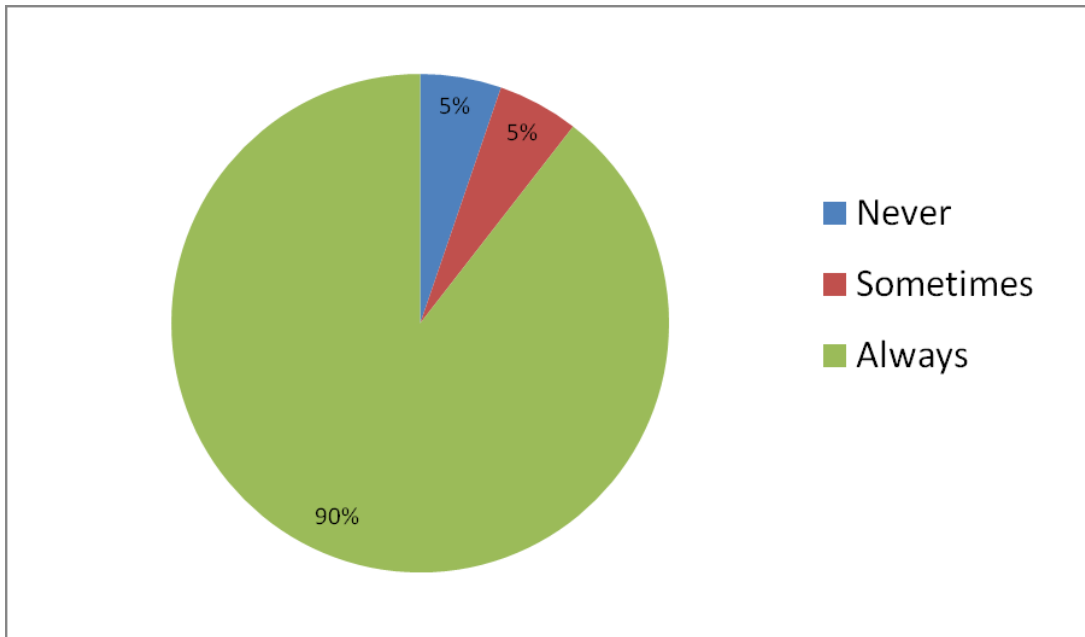
The school encourages me to attempt difficult work.
