As part of this term's topic on Victorian life, we have booked a trip to the Workhouse in Ripon to take part in a 'Rich and Poor Day' on Wednesday 7th February 2018.

This trip will comprise of visits not only to the Workhouse to learn about the Board who oversaw its running, but also a mock trial at the Courthouse and a visit to the Prison and Police Museum – we have a lot to fit into the day!

The bus will leave school at 9.00am promptly and will return by the end of school.

To gain the most out of the day, we would like the children to experience the visit dressed in Victorian costume. This only needs to be a white shirt/blouse and black trousers/skirt and any additions the children may want to wear such as flat cap, waistcoat, mop cap or apron. It may be very cold so children will need to bring coats for moving between the museums.

Please ensure your child has packed lunch and drink (no chocolate or fizzy drinks please) in a suitable bag.

The cost of the visit is £13.50 which will cover the cost of the coach and the workshops led by Museum staff. Payments will be due by the 3rd February. If you have concerns about payment, please see your child's teacher as soon as possible.
