We have been extremely impressed with how well the children have settled into their new class and routines this week and it has been wonderful to see our classrooms full of smiling faces, ready to learn! We would love to welcome you in to see our classrooms and meet us face to face. We would like this to be as soon as possible so that we can put faces to names for our parents. So, we invite you to join us straight after school on Thursday 12th September. Year 1 children and parents please head into Poppy class and then there will be an opportunity to go to Forget Me Not Class after. Year 2 children and parents please head into Bluebell Class and then there will be an opportunity to go to Forget Me Not Class after. We know that some of you may not be able to attend then, however if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

It is very important that we have good communication between school and home, so that the needs of your child are best met. Your child's teacher will respond as soon as they are available. The positive involvement of parents/carers in education is vital in order to give your child the best possible support throughout their time in school. You are the ones who know your child best and can help us bring out the best in them.

Children must have a PE kit in school every day. PE in KS1 is going to be on the following days:- Bluebell – Monday, Poppy – Tuesday and Forget Me Not – Thursday. For safety reasons during PE lessons long hair must be tied up and all jewellery removed.

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This year we will continue to focus on our three school rules - Be Ready, Be Respectful and Be Safe. Children who follow these rules consistently will be awarded "Dojos". Dojos are also awarded for amazing work. Dojos collected will also be added to the class house point chart and the house with the most points across the school will be announced every Friday. We will also be focusing on GOLD around school. GOLD is how we move around school. G is for Give Way, O is for Only Walk, L is for Look and Listen, D is for Don't talk. Children get to show amazing work to a different member of staff in school. Each week there will be one special mention in assembly depending on the school's termly focus.

Reading

We ask that you continue to hear your child read at home on a regular basis, four times per week is the minimum expectation. This only need be for 5 minutes per time. It is better to practise more regularly for a short time than to read for longer and make reading feel like a chore. Please see separate reading letter for more information regarding this.

Spelling and Fluency Bee

Starting from next Friday, spellings will be sent home weekly matched to the Little Wandle programme that we follow in school. These will be tested each week in class. Again a little practice each day is better than trying to 'cram' on the day of the test. Spelling books need to be returned on a Wednesday, children will be tested on a Thursday and returned home on a Friday.

Children will be sent home a weekly maths Fluency Bee sheet and tests the children on key facts that they need to recall by the end of Key Stage One. They will have learnt these number facts during the week in school. Children will be tested on a Thursday and they will receive a new sheet on a Friday.

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Your child Two will bring home a homework book each Friday that will contain a task to be completed that week. This will be a Maths or English task set at an appropriate level for your child and will be linked to recent learning. These homework tasks should be completed and returned to school on a Wednesday to be marked and new work set. These tasks should not take more than about 10 minutes. If you find that they are taking longer than this, please speak to your child's teacher. For Year 2 children homework books will be sent home from Friday 20th September for Year 1 children this will start after October half term.

Educational Visits

This term to support our work on the Great Fire of London we will be going to visit the Fire Station, more information will be sent out about this nearer the time. We will also be hatching chicks from eggs in school during the first half term to help us understand about life cycles.
